COURSE DESCRIPTION :

- ▶ Oyster card Zone 1/2: £40 per week
- ▶ Sunday trips: £60 per trip
- ▶ Weekend London activity: £40 per activity

For students who are under 16: full-board, evening & weekend activities need to be included if travelling alone without any legal guardian.

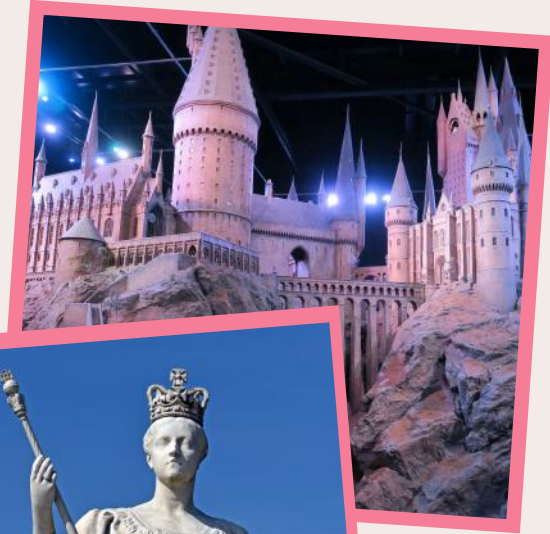
